## COMMITTEE ON UNIVERSITY EXTENSION JANUARY 26, 2023 MINUTES

The Chair informed the Committee that the Provost has asked Senate Committee's to engage with the lead coordinators for strategic planning initiatives related to their charges. The Committee was identified as being a key faculty Senate Committee for the following initiatives: Grow non-resident enrollment; Grow new 4-1 & 3-2 master's programs; Invest in centers of research and development on campus; Carnegie classification- Community Engagement. The Chair informed the Committee that leaders of the initiatives will periodically attend Committee meetings to gather input and provide updates.

The Committee welcomed the Provost to the meeting to provide an update on the strategic plan initiative for the Carnegie classification — Community Engagement. The Provost shared that UNEX models community engagement well across communities and of a plan to draft a list of UNEX courses as part of the classification project. Dean Vaughn confirmed that UNEX is working to provide the data needed for the classification. The Provost asked that other leaders from the initiative be invited to future Committee meetings as their work continues on the project.
