The UC Office of the President concluded a 30-day consultation period in late November on a proposed 2020-21 “curtailment” program that was proposed in October, as one option among many available to address economic challenges created by the pandemic. The final program was titled the Job Protection Program. Each campus was asked to evaluate the implementation of this program to meet its needs and financial challenges. Chancellor Wilcox has asked that we engage in campus-wide consultation about this program, both to answer specific questions about the program and gathering campus input on it. The Chancellor will make a final decision on what action, if any, UCR will take regarding this specific program in early January 2021. It should be noted that at this time it appears there are at least six (6) UC campuses that have already decided not to implement this program, as they will use their existing budget reduction/savings plans to address the overall objective. **To read the full text, view the [President Job Protection Program memo](#).**
