The Committee on Rules and Jurisdiction reviewed the proposed Bylaw Change to the School of Public Policy Bylaws PP1.2, PP4.1, PP4.1.6 (2nd Round). The R&J committee thanks the School of Public Policy for taking up the recommendation to follow the medical school's solution of recording non-Senate members' votes. However, the committee recommends the addition of either one of the following clarifying statements to elucidate the process. R&J's concern is how SPP will determine which issues are Senate or non-Senate related.

Option #1: The non-Senate members have non-voting, advisory participation like the student reps.

or

Option #2: The non-Senate members can vote only in an advisory capacity on all issues.
