RE: **[Campus Review] Regulation Change: *Proposed Changes to Regulation R1.6.1***

The Executive Committee of the School of Public Policy has reviewed the proposed changes to Regulation R1.6.1. We are in agreement that a change is necessary and support the option to rewrite the regulation such that the student may repeat only those courses in which a grade of NC or C- or lower was received.

While we feel that another proposed solution may help reduce incidences where students may still be caught in a “no-persons” land<sup>1</sup>, we feel that we need more information from departments and programs across campus on the perceived impacts and issues surrounding this solution to accurately assess this proposed solution.

<sup>1</sup> This alternative solution was written as: “A student may repeat only those courses in which a grade of C-, D, F, or NC was received. Course prerequisites cannot require grade minima that exceed a C because they would strand subsets of otherwise passing students who could neither satisfy the prerequisites nor repeat the prerequisite course.”
