The CHASS Executive Committee submitted responses about the Proposed Bylaw Revision: Bylaw Appendix 5 (5.3.1 and Addition of 5.3.11) email by May 20, 2019.

While the committee has no objections to the proposal, the following questions were raised: the original language of the proposal, which has now been changed, used to specify who the “Chancellor’s Designee” could be, namely a person “such as the Executive Vice Chancellor and Provost.” That language was removed. Was that done for any particular reason? Also, it was asked whether the university has a parallel set of regulations for non-Senate members.

Otherwise, there were no objections and our committee approved the proposed revisions.
