The School of Business Executive Committee discussed the proposal for suspension of iEval for Spring 2020. Below is a summary of comments received from Executive Committee members:

Committee members are unanimously opposed to suspending iEval as they felt that it could provide valuable student feedback to faculty members about their online teaching prowess, particularly as more courses may be offered online in the future. Moreover, it is also important for students to feel like they still have a way to express their views. Instead, members felt that faculty members can be provided the option of not including teaching evaluations from Spring 2020 in their merit and promotion files.
