Re: Proposal to Extend COVID-19 Remote Instruction at UCR

The Committee on Rules and Jurisdiction reviewed the Proposal to Extend COVID-19 Remote Instruction at UCR and finds the wording consistent with the code of the Academic Senate.

The committee would like to add that the dual-delivery option may inadvertently pressure faculty to deliver the courses both remotely and in-person, if there is no effective way to live stream the physical class to the remote audience. Currently in the proposal, it is unclear who will bear many of the logistical responsibilities associated with such classes, though presumably these responsibilities will fall on faculty.
