## **[Campus Review] Proposed Agreement: *UCR Online Course Agreement (ILTI Agreement)***

On behalf of Senate Division Chair Dylan Rodriguez I attach a draft intellectual property licensing agreement for online courses as forwarded for review by Associate Provost Ken Baerenklau. Per the Associate Provost, this agreement would grant the University a temporary license to use course materials developed with exceptional University Resources.

After the agreement expires, the University no longer has a license to use the course materials. A template agreement was distributed by UCOP in 2014 (attached) and modified with input from Campus Counsel and former Senate Division Chair Wudka. However, it was not forwarded for Senate review and therefore never finalized. A licensing agreement such as this is required for ILTI (Innovative Learning Technology Initiative) courses and for any course materials created with the use of Exceptional University Resources. As the Provost's Office will direct some campus lottery funds to support more online course development beginning in Fall 2019, this type of agreement is necessary and the attached is being forwarded for Senate review.
