

RE: Consultation: Campus Five-Year Planning Perspectives for 2024-2029

The CHASS Executive Committee reviewed and discussed the Consultation: Campus Five-Year Planning Perspectives for 2024-2029. The committee has no concerns or comments about the details included in the spreadsheet, but in our discussion raised two points about a moratorium and about discontinuances that are not addressed in the spreadsheet:

- 1.) The Sustainability Major was put into Moratorium (effective August 2023), and the committee believes it would be helpful to include information about programs in moratorium on this spreadsheet.
- 2.) The minors: Southeast Asian Studies, Chicano Bilingual-Bicultural Studies, Peace and Conflict Studies, Urban Studies, and Western American Studies and the major: Humanities, Arts, and Social Sciences have remained in the “Transfers, Consolidations, Discontinuances and Disestablishments” area for quite some time. The CHASS Executive Committee would like to know the status of discontinuance for these minors and major.
