RE: Proposal: Proposed Revisions to Senate Bylaw 140 (UCAADE)

The CHASS Executive Committee reviewed the proposed revisions and noted that the revisions fundamentally change the nature of the work done on the committee, so perhaps a renaming would be appropriate. The committee also noted it would be valuable to clearly articulate what forms of response or corrective actions are expected to be enacted once inequities are identified/documented, in order to avoid reporting fatigue often encountered across the system. A clear guidance on best practices or recommended actions to take would be helpful. The committee also discussed and asked questions regarding timeliness, how often would the committee be providing feedback to the University and how often would it be conferring/reporting, as well as to whom?
