Re: [Campus Review] Proposal: *Priority Registration for Timely Completion of Student Evaluations of Teaching*

The Committee on Faculty Welfare (CFW) reviewed the proposal for *Priority Registration for Timely Completion of Student Evaluations of Teaching*. CFW has the following comments:

- We feel that if this proposal is implemented, transfer students should be given priority between the “returning completers” and “returning non-completers.”
- We would be interested in seeing the data from this trial after the trial period. In particular, we would be interested in seeing response rates from graduating seniors who are not affected by this incentive.
- It is not clear if this proposal is good for students, since one of the goals of priority registration is to ensure students who need certain courses to graduate are able to enroll in these courses.
