The SOE Executive Committee reviewed the Proposed Revisions to Senate Bylaw 192 and Senate Regulations 636 and 761. Comments/feedback were solicited at our executive committee meeting and via email.

Our feedback on the document is minimal. In this proposed bylaw change, the committee appears to be aiming to replace use of "remedial" with "preparatory", but a few instances of "remedial" were uncorrected (761 A - "Tigonometry is considered remedial if.."; 192 B 8 - "Report on preparatory and remedial education...". Is the remaining use of "remedial" intentional or erroneous?
